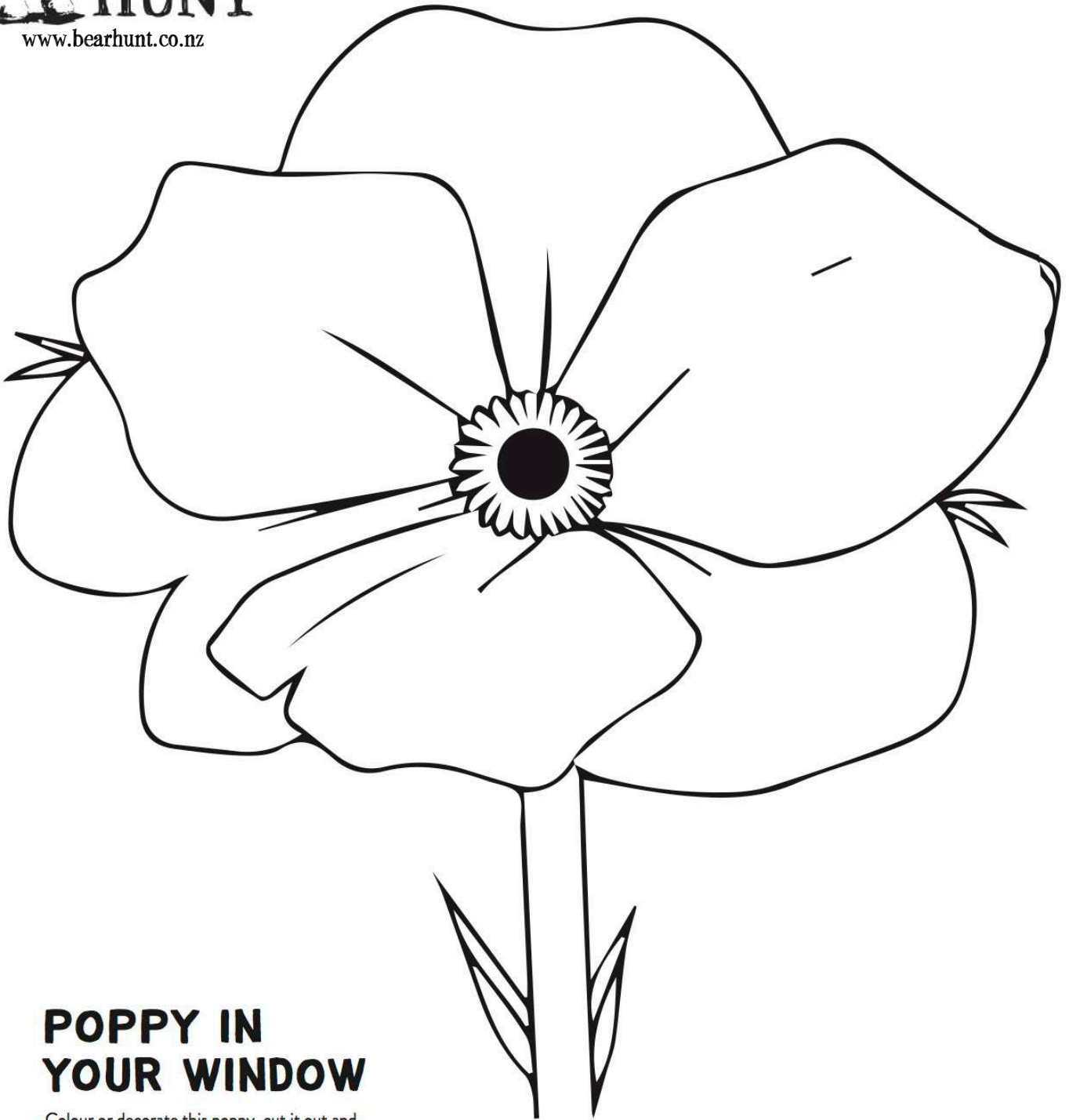

DID YOU KNOW?

There are 3 coloured poppies for ANZAC Day that represent different very important things.

WHITE - Worn for over 80 years, an international symbol for remembering all of the casualties of war and represents peace.

PURPLE - Worn to remember all of the very special animals that died at war.

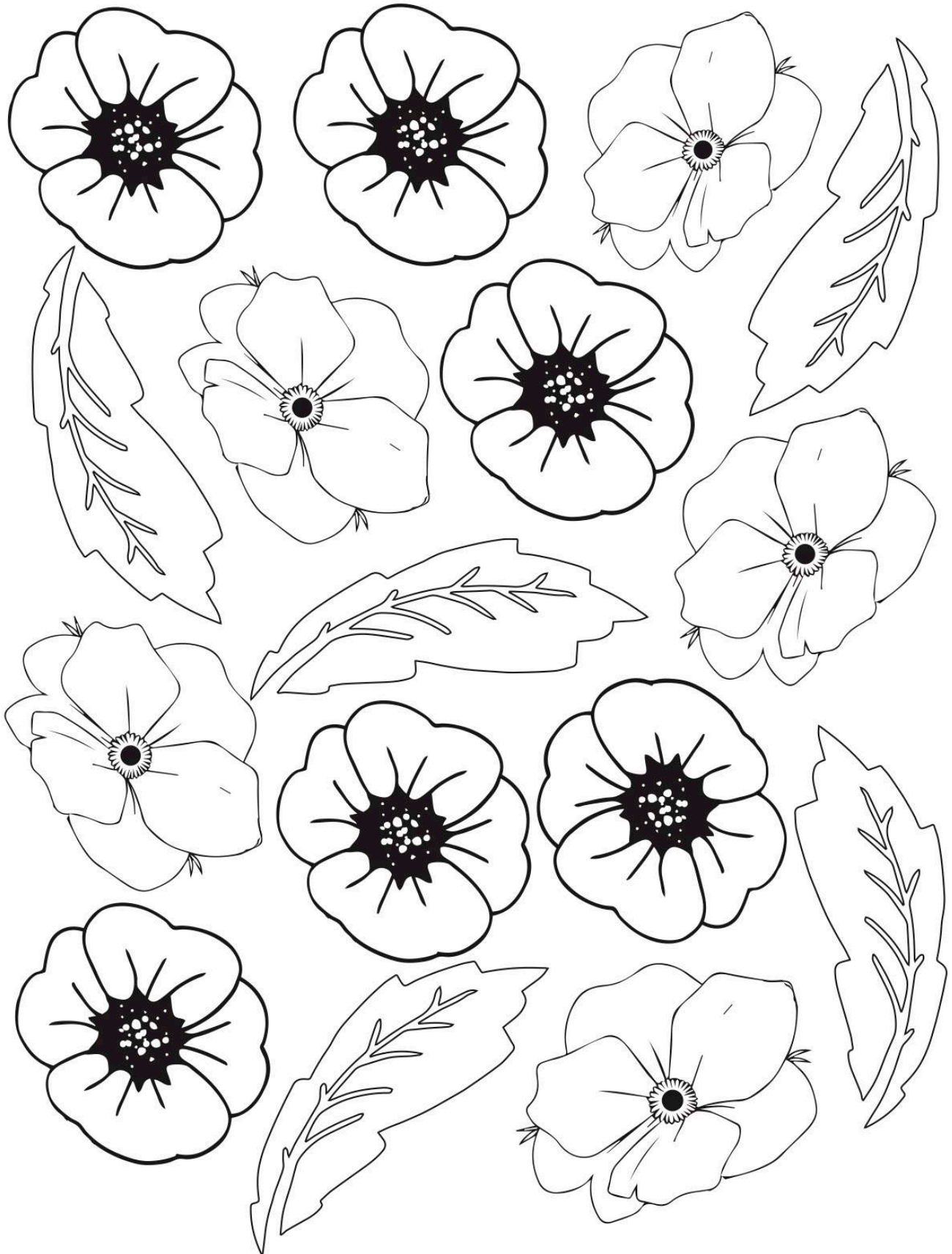
RED - The most commonly worn, the red poppy is symbol to remember the people that went to war and fought for their countries.
